Participants will need own carving tools and some other materials – see list below. A limited amount of extra materials will be available for purchase.

The terms *moku* (wood) and *hanga* (print), refer to contemporary woodblock printmaking using traditional Japanese materials and techniques. Japanese woodblock prints -- rich in history, influence and popularity -- are made much the same way today as they were 400 years ago. Appreciation of their delicate beauty, ranges of textures and values, as well as their timeless, low-tech simplicity, endures. Participants in this course will be instructed on the traditional Japanese techniques of woodcarving, color registration, and hand pressed printing. Open to adults 17 and above. All levels welcome.

Each participant will have the opportunity to exhibit his or her print at the Art Hop on Friday, December 5th!

With wood and paper to make a two color woodblock print including:

One Woodblock (to be carved on both sides – extra blocks available for purchase)
One sheet Paper (for eight prints – extra paper available for purchase)
